
Mahannah's Widow Is Chief Beneficiary

One hundred shares of Kelsey Wheel company stock also goes to the widow.

Two sisters, Mrs. Lottie Edwards and Mrs. Ella Post, get \$2,000 each; Mrs. L. J. Davis, another sister, gets \$1,000; Inez P. Davis and Miss Sadie Mahannah get \$500 each.

The remainder of the estate, which is valued at thousands of dollars, is willed to four sons, share and share alike. They are Floyd R., J. C., A. A. and M. E. Mahannah.

Joseph C. Mahannah, who was secretary and treasurer of the wheel company, now fills his father's office.
