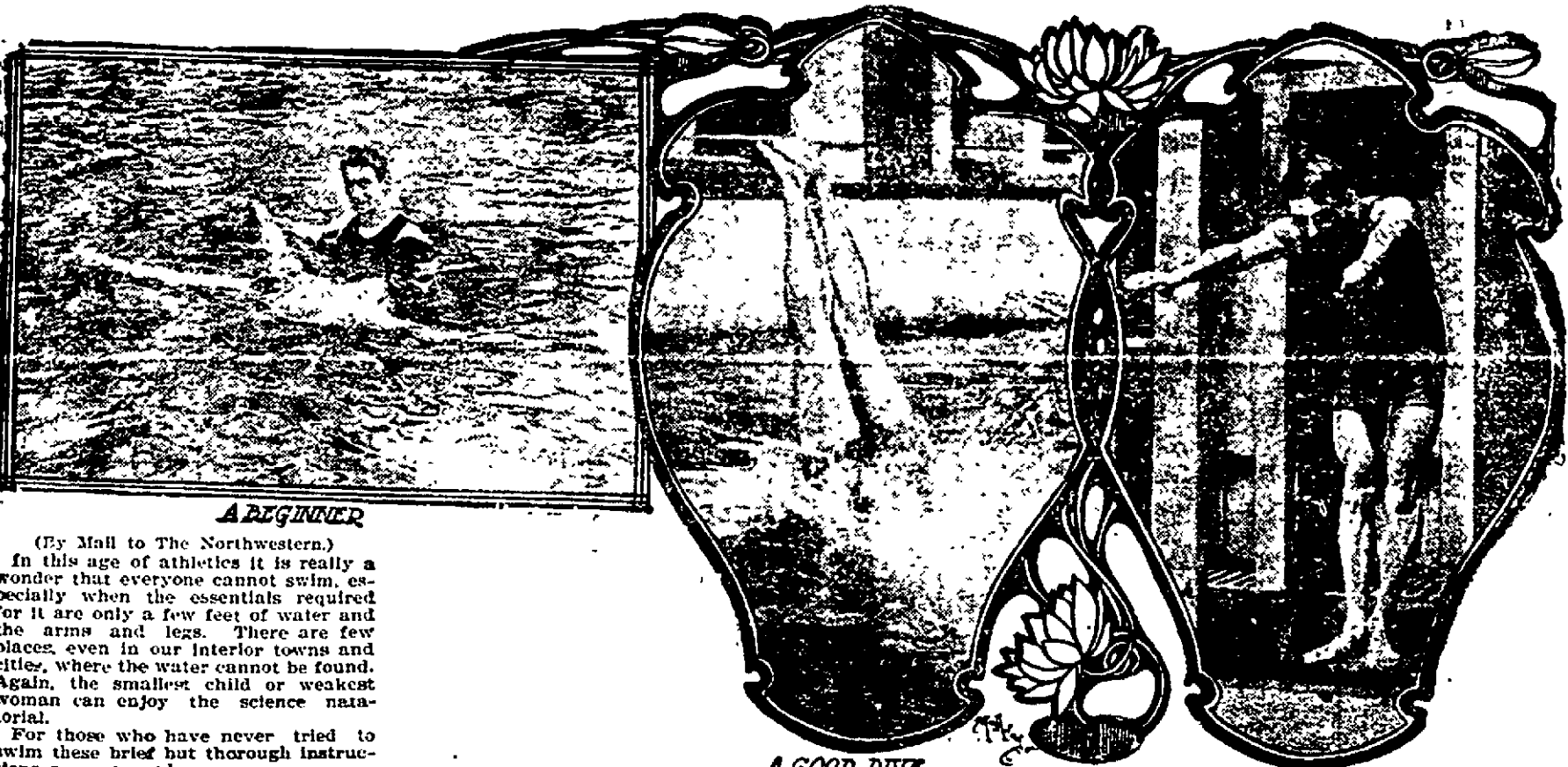


Hints on Swimming—Good Advice to Beginners

In the case of athletes it is really a wonder that everyone cannot swim, especially when the essentials required for it are only a few feet of water and the arms and legs. There are few places, even in our lake towns, where the water cannot be found. Again, the smallest child or weakest woman can enjoy the science of swimming.

For those who have never tried to swim these brief but thorough instructions are prepared.

When undressed rub yourself down with a rough towel, and then walk into the water.

The first thing to be done on entering is to put your head under water, open your eyes and accustom yourself to the look of things under water, which will overcome any fear that you may possess. After this has been done two or three times place any object that is light and white at the bottom of the water, then try to pick it up, which will necessitate opening the eyes.

When thoroughly accustomed to the water, get an air bladder.
