SECTIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

Our 91st Annual Meeting held in Scottsdale, AZ, brought us together in celebration of our accomplishments in 2003. The two-day event was especially memorable because USTA Chairman of the Board and President Alan Schwartz joined us for all activities, including a half-day planning retreat with section board members and staff. Membership reached a high of 12,590. More juniors have been playing in tournaments than ever and a record 522 entered the Southwest Junior Closed. USA League Tennis has grown to 7,900 players in the Adult, Senior, Mixed, and Super Senior divisions and seven USA League Tennis teams placed in nationals. Our USA Team Tennis for Youth program had 3,800 kids involved with 675 playing at sectionals. The section increased funding for the development

of tennis in local communities through grants to Chartered USTA Community Tennis Associations and programs.

Brian Cheney and Virginia (Ginger) Renouard were inducted into the Southwest Tennis Hall of Fame. Section volunteers receiving USTA Volunteer Service Awards at the 2003 USTA Annual Meeting were Jim Reffkin and Christy Balsiger for fifteen and ten years of service, respectively. USTA Life Umpire awards went to George Yuhas, Lillian Donley, Richard Bozeat, and Phil Davis. Joseph Hawkins was awarded the PTR Jana Hunsaker Grant in recognition of his commitment to wheelchair tennis. Outstanding award recipients included the Robert Geiger Family as the Southwest Section Family of the Year and Rosemarie Shellabarger Tennis Center

as Southwest's Member Organization of the Year.

For the first time, our Southwest Tennis Foundation partnered with Coleman Vision Tennis Championships, a USTA Women's Challenger, raising \$14,000 to benefit middle school tennis. Another first was the USPTA STAR awarded to Britt Feldhausen of Tucson for service to the school children of his city through the Tucson Community Tennis Program. Santa Fe, NM, was named a First Serve site. We formed our first Coaches Commission, bringing together top coaches from throughout the section.

Southwest players selected for USA Senior International Cup Teams were Andy Stoner, Brian Cheney, Anne Guerrant, Sherri Bronson, and Jason Morton. Clarence Renouard volunteered many hours providing publicity for all the USA Senior Cup teams.

As we move into 2004, all Southwest USTA members

will receive a new *Player's Handbook*. Maricopa County Tennis Coalition will be dissolved, and its activities will continue under the USTA Phoenix Area. USA Tennis funding will support these activities and those of USTA Southeastern Arizona and USTA Greater El Paso.

We look forward to continued growth and success as we update our strategic plan and prepare to be involved in the initiative for Tennis Welcome Centers. Revised strategic priorities will include Multicultural Participation. A Points Per Round Ranking system will be in place for junior and adult players and Tournament Data Manager will be in use for all sanctioned tournaments. We welcome Tim Russell of Phoenix as our new President, who has reinforced the goals set at our planning retreat by stating at our annual meeting, "we are not only committed to a shared vision of the future, but the effort necessary to ensure the realization of this vision."
