

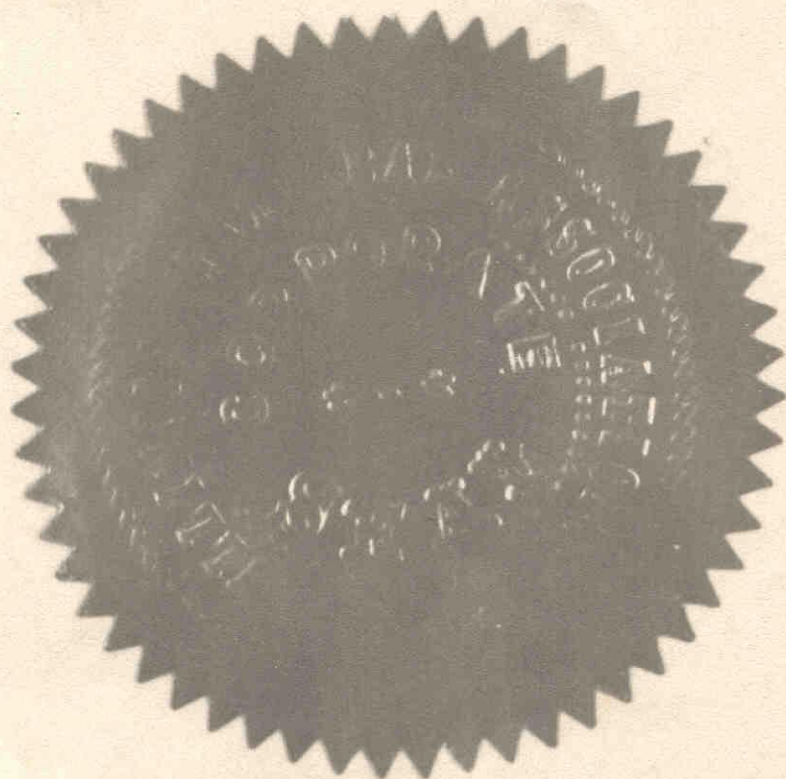
THE ILLINOIS STATE BAR ASSOCIATION
