

W. T. AP MADOC, EX-LEGISLATOR, LAWYER, DIES

William Tudor ApMadoc, 83, of 2520 Sheridan rd., Evanston, a lawyer for 66 years prior to his retirement in 1952 and a former member of the Illinois legislature, died yesterday in an Evanston convalescent home. He was a state representative from the Hyde Park district in Chicago from 1906 thru 1912. He had practiced law from 1896 to 1952 and had maintained offices at 30 N. La Salle st. On completion of 60 years in the law business, he was honored by the Illinois Bar association. Mr. ApMadoc leaves his wife, Nelle; a son, William Jr.; a daughter, Mrs. Emmett Brown, and six grandchildren. Services will be private.
